Move to BromCom My Child a School (MCAS) App

At Archbishop Tenison's School we are no longer using ParentPay, SchoolComms and Edulink. We are now using **BromCom - 'My Child at School' app (MCAS)**.

If you are repeatedly receiving emails to reset your password, it is because our system shows you have not signed up yet. If you have not received an email about this, please check your spam folder.

Over the next term we will be moving all of our systems to BromCom, so it is really important that you sign up. This will ensure you receive communication from school, be able to top up your child's lunch account, make payments for trips, report absences and help support your child through their education.

Once completed, the solar PV is expected to provide 85% of the total electricity use of the school, and could provide over £110,000 of savings.

Shree Swaminarayan Temple
Once completed, the solar PV is expected to provide 70% of the total electricity use of the Temple, and could provide over £20,000 of savings.
