## Year 11 Drama visit - 'Wicked' at The Apollo Theatre

As part of the GCSE level Drama curriculum, we have arranged to take our Year 11 Drama group to see a performance of 'Wicked' at The Apollo Theatre on **Wednesday, 11th January 2023**. This is an exciting opportunity for pupils to see this play in the intended sphere – the theatre.

The performance begins at 2.30pm. We will therefore leave school at 1.00pm and walk to East Croydon Station where we will travel to London Victoria by train. We will then walk along to the Apollo Theatre. We will return to East Croydon at approximately 6.00pm, where pupils will be dismissed. Pupils are advised to either eat in the school canteen before we leave or to bring a packed lunch with them to eat on the train or before we enter the theatre.

Pupils should wear their school uniform, as they will be in school in the morning before travelling to the theatre. As it will be mid-January, they should be prepared for inclement weather and wear waterproof and warm clothing.

The visit will be led by Mr Papisideris. **The cost for this trip is £22.91, please make payment for this visit via [ParentPay](#) by Friday, 25th November.** Please notify the school if there are any changes to your contact/emergency contact details, medical information or if your child has any food allergies etc. Pupils will need to have their oyster/zip card, with enough money available for travel.

Pupils on a school visit are ambassadors for Archbishop Tenison's CE High School and we have always been proud of the high standards of behaviour shown by our pupils. Therefore, any behaviour concerns in school will be considered when initial payments are accepted. Additionally, we reserve the right to withdraw any pupil whose behaviour causes concern, at any time, prior to the departure of this visit. Please be aware that a refund will not be issued should your child be withdrawn from the visit in these circumstances.

If you have any medical concerns that you think may prevent your son/daughter from participating in the visit, please ask your GP or Practice Nurse for advice and inform me before making payment. If your son/daughter has asthma or any allergies, please ensure that they bring their inhaler/epipen with them.
