Careers Education and Guidance will equip students with the skills, knowledge and understanding required to ensure their future success in their chosen field.

Students need to develop an in-depth understanding of career options and a level of self-awareness to refine their decision making skills in order to make effective transitions throughout their career and not just to the next transition.

Careers awareness and the world of work features in our PSD programme which runs throughout Years 7-11 and aspects include:
