#### Homework

Thank you to all of the parents who responded to our recent homework and especially for the extended written comments left at the end of the form. We are looking carefully at how homework presented to our pupils and perceived by our pupils and have run a similar questionnaire with pupils from each year group to explore their concerns and perceptions.

I would like to share with you some of the areas we are working on with regards to homework as a result of the surveys:

- We are working towards trialling a parental homework app called Beedle which would keep parents better informed about their child's homework. We hope to trial Beedle with a sample group before the end of this term and if successful, it will be rolled out more widely in 2022-2023.
- The homework timetable is being redesigned and simplified to look at when pupils should complete their work and the maximum length of time work should take.
- Staff have had a reminder about how to set work via Teams Assignments so that pupils and students have more clarity regarding homework tasks.

### Td/IPV and MenACWY

The 3-in-1 Td/IPV vaccine, is given by a single injection into the upper arm to boost protection against 3 separate diseases: **tetanus, diphtheria and polio**.

The MenACWY vaccine is given by a single injection into the upper arm and protects against 4 strains of the meningococcal bacteria – A, C, W and Y – which cause **meningitis** and blood poisoning (septicaemia).

### Human Papillomavirus (HPV)

The national NHS HPV vaccination programme uses a vaccine called Gardasil. 2 doses are required, with a minimum of 6 months' gap between each dose.

Gardasil protects against 4 types of HPV: 6, 11, 16 and 18. Between them, types 16 and 18 are the cause of most cervical cancers in the UK (more than 70%).

These types of HPV also cause some anal and genital cancers, and some cancers of the head and neck.
