MFL A Level Course Overview

- We teach French and German and offer non-taught courses for some languages for native speakers (as long as an Alevel exists), we follow the AQA specification
- In year 12 we talk about trends in the culture of the TL such as the changing nature of family, film and music, heritage technology and tourism.
- In year 13 we deal with more academic topics, such as immigration and integration, politics and history.
- We study a film and a book in the target language and learn what this reveals about the country and its culture.
- There is also an independent research project, where you choose a topic of interest to you and research it. This is really great practice for university and independent study skills.
