Subjects

At the top end there were A* grades in Maths (1), Physics (1), Further Maths (1), Photography (1) and Sociology (1). There were also 4 A grades in English Literature, 4 in Maths, 3 in Geography and 2 in each of Art, Biology, Economics, Photography and Sociology.

Big successes at A*-C were French, Further Maths, PE and Spanish (100%), Photography (92%), Art (91%), Sociology (86%), Maths (85%), Geography (83%), Drama (80%), History (79%), English Literature (78%) and Film Studies (71%).

In the EPQ (Extended Project Qualification) there was huge success. 48% of grades were A*-A; 71% at A*-B and 95% at A*-C

In the world of linear A Levels, there were fewer AS exams than in previous years but those of our Year 12s who did sit them in subjects like Maths, Sociology, Film Studies, Classical Civilization and Government and Politics are also celebrating this morning. Of the 80 exams sat, 74% were at A^* -C and there were particular successes at A^* -C in Further Maths (100%), Film Studies (86%), Sociology (75%) and Government and Politics (73%).
