Potential Tram Strikes – 7th to 9th May 2024

Please be aware that London Trams are due to strike next week. Should the strike go ahead, please plan your child's journey to school, consider alternative routes and allow enough time.

Tuesday 7 May and Wednesday 8 May

- No service expected before 07:00 or after 18:00 on the whole of the London Trams network.
- A **reduced service** will operate between:
 - Wimbledon and Reeves Corner
 - East Croydon and Beckenham Junction/New Addington
- **No service will operate through Croydon town centre or to/from Elmer's End all day**

Thursday 9 May

- Services are expected to start later than normal, with possible disruption throughout the day.
