SEPTEMBER TO OCTOBER

Visit Archbishop Tenison's for an Open Event

You will have the opportunity to come and explore our school community. You will hear from the Headteacher and other key members of staff, meet subject teachers and have the opportunity to take part in different activities. The transition team will be available to answer any questions about moving to secondary school.

MAY TO JUNE

Meeting you at your Primary School

Where there are several pupils joining from the same school, we will arrange to come and visit you at your primary school. This will give you the opportunity to ask questions and for staff to get to know you. Your teachers will provide information to help plan individual support.

JUNE

Ice Breaker Session

For those of you joining alone or with only one or two pupils from your school, you will be invited to an ice breaker session. This will give you the opportunity to get to know some other pupils before the Transition Day in July.

SEPTEMBER

Year 7 Induction

Before the start of term, there will be an Induction Day for Year 7 pupils. You will meet your tutor group, have your school photograph taken, get familiar with the school environment and key members of staff.

SEPTEMBER

Beginning of Term Service

Your parents/carers will be invited to join us for the Beginning of Term Service at St. Matthew's Church.

OCTOBER

Apply for a place at Archbishop Tenison's

JUNE

SEN/Support Transition Day

Some pupils will be invited for additional transition support based on information from primary schools.

JULY

Transition Day

You will have the opportunity to come into Archbishop Tenison's to meet key staff, experience lessons and school life, and meet other pupils joining Tenison's in September.
