



## Archbishop Tenison's Church of England High School A-Level Exam Results – Summer 2025

We want to take this opportunity to congratulate our Year 13 students on the excellent results they have achieved this year. Thursday, 14th August, was a joyful and exciting day for our whole school community, we were able to celebrate with students as they collected their results and heard of their considerable success in reaching their chosen destinations in Higher Education, in an apprenticeship or, in some cases, giving them the grades they need for a future application during a gap year. This year we are pleased that there has been a positive increase across academic achievement, the percentage of passes across subjects and the number of subjects which is testament to the hard work that our students put in.

As a school, we are impressed and proud by the determination and character our students have shown. At Archbishop Tenison's 45% of grades were A\* - B (this is a 20% increase compared to last year) and 97% A\* - E.

Well done to all those involved in achieving this across our many different Sixth Form subjects. Subjects which achieved 100% at A\*- C were Art and Design, Classical Civilisation, Geography, History, Latin, Sociology, Religious Studies. We are also very pleased that as a sixth form our value added is above average.

We also want to note some outstanding individual achievements by students whose hard work and commitment achieved brilliant grades across all three, subjects. Particular congratulations go to: Anna (A\*ABB), Hannah R (A\*AB), Elijah (ABB), Esther (ABB), Jai (ABB), Samuel (ABB), Clarice (AAC), Hannah W (ABC), Shoban (ABC) and Lilly (BBC).

Hannah R has been awarded a place at Cambridge University to study Geography – Hannah was given the conditional offer of AAB, and we are proud that she did better than what Cambridge University requested. Soleil was awarded a place at St. Andrews (Scotland) which topped number 1 in 2024 above Oxford and Cambridge.
